Position

Reporting to and in partnership with the US Director, the Fundraising Event Intern (Intern) will assist the Director in all areas of fundraising through events. The Intern will be tasked with managing third party events, online fundraisers, inperson dinner parties, and supply drives. The goal is that the Intern will be able to promote the availability of these fundraising tools to bring in new fundraisers raising at least \$5,000 per semester.

The desired individual will have an outgoing and friendly personality; demonstrated professionalism and tact in communications with a diversity of individuals; strong organizational and time management skills; acute attention to detail and ability to work well independently.

Hours and Compensation

Part-time 5-10 hours per week; unpaid internship with flexible virtual office hours. We will work with Universities / Colleges to establish internship credit. Compensation will be reviewed at the $\frac{1}{2}$ way point of the semester.

- Creation of a guide to support supply drives.
- Track needed supplies at Bolingo Village.

- Assist in processing supply donations and ensuring the addition of these donations in our database.

- Host a third-party event.
- Attend all-staff meetings.
