Position

Reporting to the US Director, the Orphan Care Intern will process monthly program data and generate reports to evaluate program effectiveness on an ongoing basis. This position will track the adherence to each child's care plan in our care village in DRC for orphaned children. In addition, the intern will conduct research on future program goals and help shape GOF programming. This position requires strong research, writing and analytical skills.

Desired individual will have a friendly personality; demonstrated professionalism and tact in communications with a diversity of individuals; strong organizational and time-management skills; acute attention to detail and ability to work well independently.

Hours and Compensation

Part-time 5-10 hours per week; unpaid internship with flexible remote office hours. We will work with Universities / Colleges to establish internship credit. Compensation will be reviewed at the ½ way point of the semester.

Responsibilities

- Support GOF programs in the Democratic Republic of Congo.
- Collect and analyze data from DRC staff.
- Prepare monthly reports on program progress and distribute to appropriate parties
- Research and recommend program improvements
- Conduct research on other NGO's working in target countries for future collaborations

- Student or recent graduate from an accredited university with a focus in Program Management, Public Health, or related field
- Strong analytical and information gathering skills, including advanced proficiency in Microsoft Excel
- Cultural sensitivity
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
