Located in Democratic Republic of Congo, Bolingo Village is the signature project of Global Orphan Foundation. By employing widowed women as licensed foster moms and building families with orphaned children, we are leveling the playing field for orphaned children in Congo and affording them the emotional, physical, and spiritual care that they need to thrive. Our sustainable children's care village goes beyond meeting basic needs by providing access to education, a clinic for consistent medical care, a farm for balanced nutrition, clean running water, a loving foster family, and space to run, play and be kids. In short, Bolingo Village is a community that allows for a robust and abundant childhood with a bright future.

Responsibilities

GOF is searching for an individual who loves researching and finding solutions. These solutions will impact the lives of the Bolingo children and help them to thrive and make a difference in a country that has little to no resources for orphaned children. From researching available species of chickens in Congo, to finding medical supplies available at lower costs, to finding organizations that provide schoolbooks to learn French for beginners.

This person would be given 1 research question every month. We anticipate 2-3 hours of research time each month.

Requirements:

- A love for children and creating the best opportunity for each individual child.
- An agreement to respect each child's privacy and keep identifiable information about children you're assigned and their stories private.
- Understanding of, or willingness to learn and respect, cultural differences.
